بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Bismillah ir-Rahman ir-Rahim

"In the name of Allah, the Entirely Merciful, the Especially Merciful"

Ayah 1

يَا أَيُّهَا الْمُزْمَلُ

Yaw ayyuhal muzzammil

"O you who wraps himself [in clothing],"

Ayah 2

قُمْ اللَّيْلَ إِلَّا قَلِيلًا

Qumil laila illaa qaleelaa

"Arise [to pray] the night, except for a little -"

Ayah 3

نِصْفَهُ أَوْ انْقُصْ مِنْهُ قَلِيلًا

Nisfahooo awinquus minhu qaleelaa

"Half of it - or subtract from it a little"

Ayah 4

أَوْ زِدْ عَلَيْهِ وَرَتِّلِ الْقُرْآنَ تَرْتِيلًا

Aw zid 'alaihi wa rattilil Qur'aana tarteela

"Or add to it, and recite the Qur'an with measured recitation."

Ayah 5

إِنَّا سَنُلْقِي عَلَيْكَ قَوْلًا ثَقِيلًا

Innaa sanulqee 'alika qawalan saqeelaa

"Indeed, We will cast upon you a heavy word."

Ayah 6

إِنَّ نَاشِئَةَ اللَّيْلِ هِيَ أَشَدُّ وَطْئًا وَأَقْوَمُ قِيلًا

Inn naashi'atal laili hiya ashaddu wat anw wa aqwamu qeela

"Indeed, the hours of the night are more effective for concurrence [of heart and tongue] and more suitable for words."

Ayah 7

إِنَّ لَكَ فِي النَّهَارِ سَبْحًا طَوِيلًا

Inna laka fin nahaari sabhan taweelaa

"Indeed, for you by day is prolonged occupation."

Ayah 8

وَاذْكُرْ اسْمَ رَبِّكَ وَتَبَتَّلْ إِلَيْهِ تَبْتِيلًا

Wazkuris ma rabbika wa tabattal ilaihi tabteelaa

"And remember the name of your Lord and devote yourself to Him with [complete] devotion."

Ayah 9

رَبُّ الْمَشْرِقِ وَالْمَغْرِبِ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ فَاتَّخِذْهُ وَكِيلًا

Rabbul mashriqi wal maghriibi laaa ilaaha illaa Huwa fattakhizhu wakeelaa

"[He is] the Lord of the East and the West; there is no deity except Him, so take Him as Disposer of [your] affairs."

Ayah 10

وَأَصْبِرْ عَلَىٰ مَا يَقُولُونَ وَاهْجُرْهُمْ هَجْرًا جَمِيلًا

Wasbir 'alaa maa yaqoo loona wahjurhum hajran jameelaa

"And be patient over what they say and avoid them with gracious avoidance."

Ayah 11

وَذَرْنِي وَالْمُكَذِّبِينَ أُولِيَ النَّعْمَةِ وَمَهْلَهُمْ قَلِيلًا

Wa zarnee walmukaz zibeena ulin na'mati wa mahhilhum qaleelaa

"And leave Me with [the matter of] the deniers, those of ease [in life], and allow them respite a little."

Ayah 12

إِنَّ لَدَيْنَا أَنْكَالًا وَحَحِيمًا

Inna ladainaaa ankaalanw wa jaheemaa

"Indeed, with Us [for them] are shackles and burning fire"

Ayah 13

وَطَعَامًا ذَا غُصَّةٍ وَعَذَابًا أَلِيمًا

Wa ta'aaman zaa ghussa tinw wa'azaaban aleemaa

"And food that chokes and a painful punishment -"

Ayah 14

يَوْمَ تَرْجُفُ الْأَرْضُ وَالْجِبَالُ وَكَانَتِ الْجِبَالُ كَثِيبًا مَّهِيلًا

Yawma tarjuful ardu waljibaalu wa kaanatil jibaalu kaseebam maheelaa

"On the Day the earth and the mountains will convulse and the mountains will become a heap of sand pouring down."

Ayah 15

إِنَّا أَرْسَلْنَا إِلَيْكُمْ رَسُولًا شَهِيدًا عَلَيْكُمْ كَمَا أَرْسَلْنَا إِلَىٰ فِرْعَوْنَ رَسُولًا

Inna arsalnaaa ilaikum rasoolan shahidan 'alikum kamaaa arsalnaaa ilaa Fir'awna Rasoolna

"Indeed, We have sent to you a Messenger as a witness upon you just as We sent to Pharaoh a messenger."

Ayah 16

فَعَصَىٰ فِرْعَوْنُ الرَّسُولَ فَأَخَذْنَاهُ أَخْذًا وَبِيلًا

Fa'asaa Fir'awnur Rasoola fa akhaznaahu akhzanw wabeelaa

"But Pharaoh disobeyed the messenger, so We seized him with a ruinous seizure."

Ayah 17

فَكَيْفَ تَتَّقُونَ إِن كَفَرْتُمْ يَوْمًا يَجْعَلُ الْوِلْدَانَ شِيبًا

Fakaifa tattaqoon in kafartum yawmany yaj'alul wildaana sheeba

"Then how can you fear, if you disbelieve, a Day that will make the children white-haired?"

Ayah 18

السَّمَاءُ مُنْفَطِرٌ بِهِ ۚ كَانَ وَعْدُهُ مَفْعُولًا

Assamaaa'u munfatirum bih; kaana wa'duhoo maf'oola

"The heaven will break apart therefrom; ever is His promise fulfilled."

Ayah 19

إِنَّ هَذِهِ تَذْكِرَةٌ ۖ فَمَنْ شَاءَ اتَّخَذَ إِلَىٰ رَبِّهِ سَبِيلًا

Inna haazihee tazkiratun fa man shaaa'at takhaza ilaa Rabbihee sabeelaa

"Indeed, this is a reminder, so whoever wills may take to his Lord a way."

*Inna Rabbaka ya'lamu annaka taqoomu adnaa min sulusa yil laili wa nisfahoo wa sulusahoo wa taaa'ifatum minal lazeena ma'ak;
 wal laahu yuqaddirul laila wanna haar; 'alima al lan tuhsoohu fataaba 'alaikum faqra'oo maa tayassara minal quraan; 'alima an sa
 yakoonu minkum mardaa wa aakharoona yadriboona fil ardi yabtaghoona min fadlil laahi wa aakharoona yuqaatiloona fee
 sabeelil laahi faqra'oo ma tayassara minhu wa aqemus salaata wa aatuz zakaata wa aqidul laaha qardan hasanaa; wa maa
 tuqadimoo li anfusikum min khairin tajidooahu 'indal laahi huwa khayranw wa a'zama ajraa; wastaghfirul laahaa innal laaha
 ghafoorur raheem.*

"Indeed, your Lord knows, [O Muhammad], that you stand [in prayer] almost two thirds of the night or half of it or a third of it, and [so do] a group of those with you. And Allah determines [the extent of] the night and the day. He has known that you [Muslims] will not be able to do it and has turned to you in forgiveness, so recite what is easy [for you] of the Qur'an. He has known that there will be among you those who are ill and others traveling throughout the land seeking [something] of the bounty of Allah and others fighting for the cause of Allah. So recite what is easy from it and establish prayer and give zakah and loan Allah a goodly loan. And whatever good you put forward for yourselves - you will find it with Allah. It is better and greater in reward. And seek forgiveness of Allah. Indeed, Allah is Forgiving and Merciful."
