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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Bismillah ir-Rahman ir-Rahim

"In the name of Allah, the Entirely Merciful, the Especially Merciful"

## Ayah 1

وَالْفَجْرِ

*Wal-Fajr*

"By the dawn"

## Ayah 2

وَلَيَالٍ عَشْرٍ

*Wa layaalin 'ashr*

"And [by] ten nights"

## Ayah 3

وَالشَّفَعِ وَالْوَتْرِ

*Wash shafi wal watr*

"And [by] the even [number] and the odd"

## Ayah 4

وَاللَّيْلِ إِذَا يَسِرَ

*Wallaili izaa yasr*

"And [by] the night when it passes,"

## Ayah 5

هَلْ فِي ذَلِكَ قَسَمٌ لِّذِي حِجْرِ

*Hal fee zaalika qasamul lizee hijr*

"Is there [not] in [all] that an oath [sufficient] for one of perception?"

#### Ayah 6

أَلَمْ تَرَ كَيْفَ فَعَلَ رَبُّكَ بِعَادٍ

*Alam tara kaifa fa'ala rabbuka bi'aad*

"Have you not considered how your Lord dealt with 'Aad -"

#### Ayah 7

إِرَمَ ذَاتِ الْعِمَادِ

*Iramaa zaatil 'imaad*

"[With] Iram - who had lofty pillars,"

#### Ayah 8

الَّتِي لَمْ يُخْلَقْ مِثْلُهَا فِي الْبِلَادِ

*Allatee lam yukhlaq misluhaa fil bilaad*

"The likes of whom had never been created in the land?"

#### Ayah 9

وَتَمُودَ الَّذِينَ جَابُوا الصَّخْرَ بِالْوَادِ

*Wa samoodal lazeena jaabus sakhra bil waad*

"And [with] Thamud, who carved out the rocks in the valley?"

#### Ayah 10

وَفِرْعَوْنَ ذِي الْأَوْتَادِ

*Wa fir'awna zil awtaad*

"And [with] Pharaoh, owner of the stakes? -"

#### Ayah 11

الَّذِينَ طَغَوْا فِي الْبِلَادِ

*Allazeena taghaw fil bilaad*

"[All of] whom oppressed within the lands"

#### Ayah 12

فَأَكْثَرُوا فِيهَا الْفَسَادَ

*Fa aksaroo feehal fasaad*

"And increased therein the corruption."

#### Ayah 13

فَصَبَّ عَلَيْهِمُ رَبُّكَ سَوْطَ عَذَابٍ

*Fasabba 'alaihim Rabbuka sawta 'azaab*

"So your Lord poured upon them a scourge of punishment."

#### Ayah 14

إِنَّ رَبَّكَ لَبَالْمُرْصَادِ

*Inna Rabbaka labil mirsaad*

"Indeed, your Lord is in observation."

#### Ayah 15

فَأَمَّا الْإِنْسَانُ إِذَا مَا ابْتَلَاهُ رَبُّهُ فَأَكْرَمَهُ وَنَعَّمَهُ فَيَقُولُ رَبِّي أَكْرَمَنِ

*Fa ammal insaanu izaab mab talaahu Rabbuhoo fa akramahoo wa na' amahoo fa yaqoolu Rabbeee akraman*

"And as for man, when his Lord tries him and [thus] is generous to him and favors him, he says, "My Lord has honored me.""

#### Ayah 16

وَأَمَّا إِذَا مَا ابْتَلَاهُ فَقَدَرَ عَلَيْهِ رِزْقَهُ فَيَقُولُ رَبِّي أَهْنَنِ

*Wa ammaaaa izaab mabtalaahu faqadara 'alaihi rizqahoo fa yaqoolu Rabbeee ahaanan*

"But when He tries him and restricts his provision, he says, "My Lord has humiliated me.""

#### Ayah 17

كَلَّا بَلْ لَا تُكْرِمُونَ الْيَتِيمَ

*Kalla bal laa tukrimooo naI yateem*

"No! But you do not honor the orphan"

#### Ayah 18

وَلَا تَحْضُونَ عَلَىٰ طَعَامِ الْمُسْكِينِ

*Wa laa tahaadoona 'alaata'aamil miskeen*

"And you do not encourage one another to feed the poor."

#### Ayah 19

وَتَأْكُلُونَ التُّرَاثَ أَكْلًا لَّمًّا

*Wa taakuloonat turaasa aklal lammaa*

"And you consume inheritance, devouring [it] altogether,"

#### Ayah 20

وَتُحِبُّونَ الْمَالَ حُبًّا جَمًّا

*Wa tuhibboonal maala hubban jammaa*

"And you love wealth with immense love."

#### Ayah 21

كَلَّا إِذَا دُكَّتِ الْأَرْضُ دَكًّا دَكًّا

*Kallaaa izaana dukkatil ardu dakkan dakka*

"No! When the earth has been leveled - pounded and crushed -"

#### Ayah 22

وَجَاءَ رَبُّكَ وَالْمَلَكُ صَفًّا صَفًّا

*Wa jaaa'a Rabbuka wal malaku saffan saffaa*

"And your Lord has come and the angels, rank upon rank,"

#### Ayah 23

وَجِئَ يَوْمَئِذٍ بِجَهَنَّمَ يَوْمَئِذٍ يَتَذَكَّرُ الْإِنْسَانُ وَأَنَّى لَهُ الذِّكْرَى

*Wa jee'e yawma'izim bi jahannnam; Yawma 'iziny yatazakkarul insaanu wa annaa lahuz zikraa*

"And brought [within view], that Day, is Hell - that Day, man will remember, but what good to him will be the remembrance?"

#### Ayah 24

يَقُولُ يَلَيْتَنِي قَدَّمْتُ لِحَيَاتِي

*Yaqoolu yaa laitanee qaddamtu lihayaatee*

"He will say, "Oh, I wish I had sent ahead [some good] for my life.""

#### Ayah 25

فَيَوْمَئِذٍ لَا يَعْذِبُ عَذَابَهُ أَحَدٌ

*Fa Yawma izil laa yu'azzibu 'azaabahooo ahad*

"So on that Day, none will punish [as severely] as His punishment,"

#### Ayah 26

وَلَا يُوثِقُ وَثَاقَهُ أَحَدٌ

*Wa laa yoosiqu wasaaqa hooo ahad*

"And none will bind [as severely] as His binding [of the evildoers]."

#### Ayah 27

يَا أَيَّتُهَا النَّفْسُ الْمُطْمَئِنَّةُ

*Yaaa ayyatuhan nafsul mutma 'innah*

"[To the righteous it will be said], "O reassured soul,"

#### Ayah 28

أَرْجِعِي إِلَىٰ رَبِّكِ رَاضِيَةً مَّرْضِيَّةً

*Irji'eee ilaa Rabbiki raadiyatam mardiyah*

"Return to your Lord, well-pleased and pleasing [to Him],"

#### Ayah 29

فَادْخُلِي فِي عِبَادِي

*Fadkhulee fee 'ibaadee*

"And enter among My [righteous] servants"

#### Ayah 30

وَادْخُلِي جَنَّتِي

*Wadkhulee jannatee*

"And enter My Paradise.""

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
